- a. Decision made in between meetings for 04/16/2023 event:
 - 03/25/2023 E-VOTE to approve up to \$1,100 for catering April 16 Social [estimate based on 50 people plus beverages, decorations, etc.]. Costco cake will serve 48 people at an additional cost of \$24.95. Molly has already purchased drinks totaling





\$20. Currently we have 39 RSVPs for the event. The guests will be charged \$10/person, members no charge. Deb reported on the decorations she had purchased totaling \$120.
